Eckenhoff Saunders has designed nearly 50 branch banks for First American Bank using a prototype the firm developed that can be adapted to any site, banking function, or municipality.

Chicago, Illinois - Lincoln Park

Located at a highly trafficked intersection of three major streets in Chicago's Lincoln Park, this 2,600 sf bank was renovated from a former restaurant.

The existing floor and roof construction was maintained, but a new brick facade was constructed on a rebuilt existing foundation.

To mark the entrance to the bank and house a 24-hour ATM lobby, a new steel and masonry tower was erected at the corner. The tower, over 35 feet in height, features a copper clad dome supported by limestone columns.

Elk Grove Village, Illinois

Eckenhoff Saunders performed a fivephase complete modernization and renovation of an existing 11,000 sf bank operations center.

Gleview, Illinois

The 3,000 sf Glenview branch is located along busy Willow Road in Glenview, Illinois.

Its broad overhanging roof and accentuated horizontal lines echo the Prairie style design of the neighboring shopping center, while the main roof and barrel-vaulted canopy roofs are clad in copper.

Skokie, Illinois

The spacious banking floor welcomes customers and provides teller positions, private offices, safe deposit boxes and conference areas. The upper floor accommodates multiple spaces for outside tenants.
