Walt co-founded Eckenhoff Saunders in 1983 and in the past three decades has overseen the planning and design of over \$2 billion in new healthcare facilities. These include four hospital campuses for the NorthShore University HealthSystem—Evanston, Highland Park, Glenbrook and Skokie—as well as three outpatient family care campuses for Ingalls Health System and two research structures in the Evanston/Northwestern University Research Park.

Walt's planning and design experience also includes banking, education, hospitality and industrial projects. His diverse portfolio includes two Unicom Thermal Technologies cooling plants (both of which won design awards from AIA Chicago), the Northern Trust Company Canal Center (900,000 SF of banking back-office space), the Southgate Market Retail Center, and the 26-story Eurostars Magnificent Mile (formerly the Dana Hotel & Spa).

Walt has been chair of the board of trustees of the Chicago Architecture Foundation and served as a Board Member for 15 years. He has chaired the Design Review Commission and the Sustainable Working Group for the Village of Glencoe, Illinois, and served on its Plan Commission. He holds both a bachelor's and a master's degree in architecture from Washington University in St. Louis and was awarded Distinguished Alumni status in 2009.
